of the educational program
7M01115 – “Educational Management”
of Pavlodar Pedagogical University named after A. Margulan

The educational program 7M01115 “Education Management” is aimed at training qualified specialists capable of effectively addressing complex tasks in the field of education. Students gain advanced knowledge in strategic planning, organization of the educational process, personnel management, and the use of modern information technologies in the educational environment.

The main goal of the program is to prepare managers and leaders who possess innovative management technologies and are ready for professional activity in various sectors of education. The program develops a systemic understanding of the educational sphere and the interrelationships between its key components.

During their studies, students develop competencies in the field of educational policy: they learn about modern trends in education and acquire skills in designing and implementing effective educational strategies. The content of the program meets employer expectations and the needs of the regional economy, relying on the strategy for the innovative development of pedagogical education and documents related to the modernization of the higher professional education system.

Graduates of the program gain broad opportunities for career advancement. They can work in educational institutions (schools, universities, colleges, preschools), education authorities (ministries, departments), consulting organizations (development of educational projects, analysis of educational system effectiveness), as well as in non-profit organizations focused on supporting and developing education.

The educational program includes components aimed at developing both professional and transferable skills. This is achieved through the integration of academic and professional outcomes, the formation of general and professional competencies, which are implemented through corresponding disciplines and their thematic content.

The content of the educational program includes the following:

1. Theoretical training, including the study of basic and specialized course cycles;
2. Industrial (professional) practice;
3. Interim and final assessments.

Each cycle of disciplines includes mandatory and elective components in proportions determined by the State Compulsory Education Standard of the Republic of Kazakhstan (SCES RK). The courses within each module are arranged in logical sequence using a system of pre-requisites and post-requisites, and indicate the competencies being developed.

The requirements for the basic content and structure of the academic disciplines are presented as a set of educational cycles and are regulated by appropriate normative documents.

Each educational cycle consists of a basic and a specialized part. The basic part forms the fundamental knowledge and skills necessary for mastering the specialty, while the specialized part provides opportunities to expand and deepen knowledge, abilities, and skills, as well as to form groups of competencies defined by the content of the core disciplines.

The description of the educational program presents the learning outcomes for each module, the conditions for recognition of prior learning, as well as the methods and approaches for program implementation and the criteria for evaluating student achievements. Each module of the program is oriented toward achieving specific learning outcomes.

The developed educational program fully corresponds to the declared level of master's training. The courses provided ensure the formation of a high level of competencies established by the "Teacher" standard. The program's provision of qualified academic and teaching staff meets all established regulatory requirements.
